


Dell Latitude E6510 Hard Drive Replacement

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INTRODUCTION

Follow this guide in order to replace the hard drive to your Dell Latitude E6510.



TOOLS:

- Spudger (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)



PARTS:

- 1 TB SSD (1)
- 250 GB SSD (1)
- Crucial MX500 500 GB SSD (1)
- 2 TB SSD (1)

Step 1 — Battery



 Unlock the two latches on the back by sliding them inwards.

Step 2






Slide the battery out from the laptop.


Step 3 — Hard Drive






- After removing the battery, unscrew the four 3 mm screws on the back plate using a Phillips #1 screwdriver.
- (i) The back plate does not need to be removed. Removed only for a clear view.

Step 4





 The hard drive should slide out of the laptop. However, if not, use a spudger to pry the hard drive out of the laptop.

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To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
