- Groove Joint Pliers (1)
- Cutting Plier (1)
- Multipurpose Glue (1)



PARTS:

• 1x IKEA Ledare Bulb (1)

Step 1 — Purpose







- Philips Hue light bulbs are expensive (\$30-70). The glass bulb is really thin and can be easily broken, resulting in an annoying aggressive light.
- On the other hand, Ikea recently released budget & strong light bulbs (\$6.99 for two). This guide will show you how to dismount an Ikea light bulb and how to use its bulb to fix a broken Philips Hue bulb with low budget.

Step 2 — Screw thread contact and LED controller







- Start by carefully removing the remaining broken glass parts from the Philips Hue lightbulb. On this
 example, glass parts have already been removed.
- Then use your Groove Joint Pliers to gently crush and remove the screw thread contact of the IKEA lightbulb.
- Once removed, you'll be able to extract the LED controller using your fingers. You might have to use a pliers again.

Step 3 — Body removal





- The bulb is sealed by the plastic & metallic body.
- Firmly use Cutting Pliers to cut and remove the body. You will only need to break the plastic layer in order to free the bulb.

Step 4 — Installing the new bulb







- Put glue on both the Ikea bulb and the Philips light bulb.
- Wait a few minutes before pressing firmly against each other.

Step 5 — Admire the magic operate



 Congratulations! You just fixed a \$60 light bulb for less than \$4!
