

INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will show you how to remove and replace the Display Assembly.

TOOLS:

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
• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove the Screw




- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer and follow the steps in <u>Before working inside your</u> <u>computer.</u>After working inside your computer, follow the instructions in <u>After working inside your computer.</u>
- Remove the screw that secures the display-cable bracket to the system board.

Step 2 — Lifting the Display Cable




• Slide and lift the display-cable bracket off the system board.

Step 3 — Open the Latch




• Open the latch and disconnect the display cable from the system board.



Step 4 — Open the Palm Rest


• Open the palm rest and keyboard assembly at an angle.

Step 5 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the screws that secure the display assembly to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

Step 6 — Lifting the Assemblies




 Slide and lift the palm rest and keyboard assembly off the display assembly.

Step 7 — Placing the Display Assembly




 Place the NEW display assembly on a flat and clean surface.

Step 8 — Align the Screw Holes




 Align the screw holes on the display hinges with the screw holes on the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

Step 9 — Replace the Screws




 Replace the screws that secure the display assembly to the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

Step 10 — Securing the Cable




 Slide the display cable into the connector on the system board and close the latch to secure the cable.

Step 11 — Sliding the Display Cable




 Slide the display-cable bracket into the slot on the palm rest and keyboard assembly.

Step 12 — Align the Screw Hole



 Align the screw hole on the displaycable bracket with the screw hole on the system board.

Step 13 — Replace the Screw



 Replace the screw that secures the display-cable bracket to the system board.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
