

# **Toshiba Satellite C55-A5310 RAM Replacement**

## TOOLS:

iFixit Opening Tool (1) Spudger (1) JIS #000 Screwdriver (1)

### Step 1 — Battery







- Push the left tab with your left hand.
- Then push the right tab with your right hand.
- While your right hand is still pushing, remove the battery with your left hand.

#### Step 2 — RAM





- Remove one JIS #000 screw.
- *i* This screw does not come out all the way, but you will still be able to open the back panel.

## Step 3



Use the plastic opening tool to pry the panel open. Be sure to do this on all four sides. Then the panel will lift off.

## Step 4



Take the nylon spudger, and push the prongs so that it releases the RAM.

## Step 5



• Once the RAM has lifted, use <u>tweezers</u> or fingers to pull it out.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
