
INTRODUCTION

The laptop's Hard Drive is where data is permanently stored and retrieved on the computer. A good Hard Drive keeps the computer running smoothly. Below are a few steps on how to effectively remove the Hard Drive.

TOOLS:

Step 1 — Battery



- Push the locking tabs away from each other.

Step 2



- Pull up on the battery to remove.

Step 3 — RAM




- Remove the 3mm Phillips #0 screw from the cover.

Step 4



- Use a plastic opening tool to lift up the cover and remove by hand.

Step 5



- Two clips secure the RAM module in place, one on each side. Using your fingers, spread the clips away from the RAM module.
- ⓘ When released, the RAM module will pop up at a slight angle.
- Lift the RAM module to an angle of about 30 degrees and slide it out.

Step 6 — Hard Drive



- Remove the three 3mm Phillips #0 screws from the hard drive.
- Remove the hard drive.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
