


HP Pavillion dm1-3010nr Cooling Fan Replacement

INTRODUCTION

If your laptop experiences overheating issues while in use, try replacing your fan. When a laptop overheats, it could limit the speed. Replacing the fan may help your device run smoother.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Battery




- Flip the device over, so that the bottom cover is exposed.
- Slide the black locking mechanism into its unlock position.

Step 2




 After unlocking the mechanism, slide the battery out of its compartment.

Step 3 — Cooling Fan



 With the battery removed, the bottom cover can be opened with your hand.


Step 4





- Use a screwdriver from your iFixit Toolkit to remove the two 5mm Phillips #0 screws shown in each picture.
- Use tweezers to carefully remove the fan's power cable from the motherboard. The cable can be seen in the second picture.

Step 5



 After removing the screws and unplugging the wire, remove the fan.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
