


Nintendo GameCube Controller Z Button Replacement


INTRODUCTION

The Z button is located above the right trigger but functions as a button.

TOOLS:

Tri-point Y0 Screwdriver (1)
Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Back Panel




- Place the controller (buttons down) on a solid surface.
- Remove the six 9.2mm Triwing Y0 screws that hold the back panel in place.


Step 2



- Gently lift the back panel up, separating it from the front panel.
- i Some of the buttons may fall out if they are knocked around.

Step 3 — Z Button





- Grab the Z-button by the peg with <u>tweezers</u> and lift it out of the controller.
- During re-assembly, make sure the plastic rim and spring fit into the slot provided, or else the case will not shut.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
