## TOOLS:

- [2.5 mm Flathead Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [Flush Wire Cutters](#) (1)
- [Precision Utility Knife](#) (1)

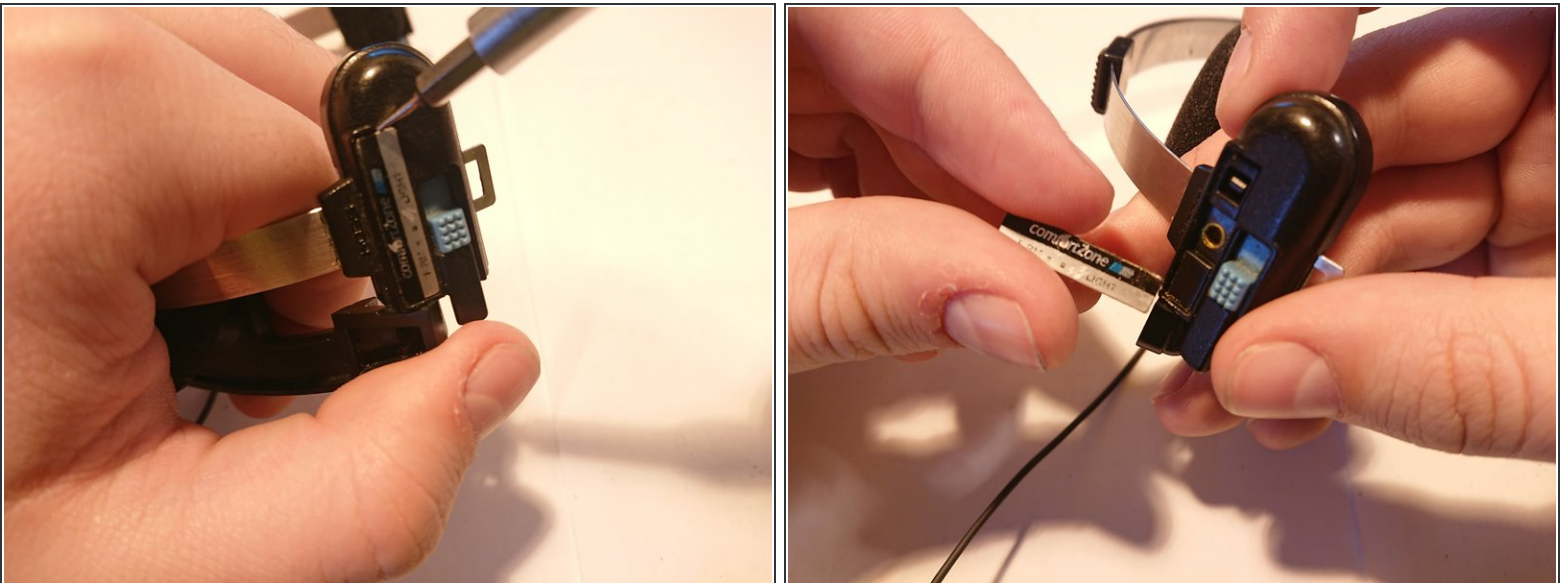
- [M2.5x7mm](#) (1)
- [Double-Sided Tape](#) (1)
- [Double-sided Foam Tape](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Remove cushion



- Remove cushion using knife.

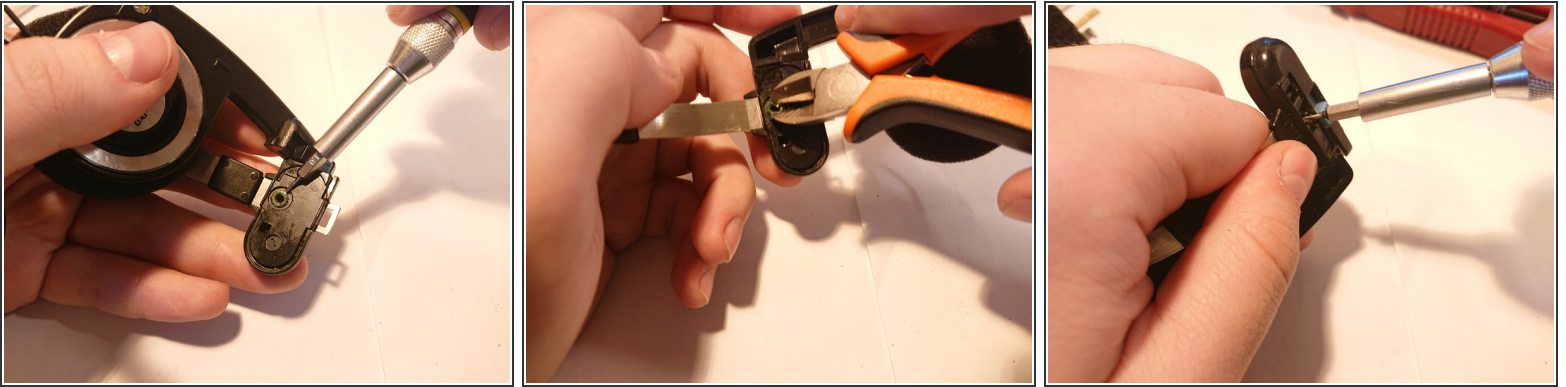
## Step 2 — Remove comfortZone label




- Remove label using flat screwdriver.

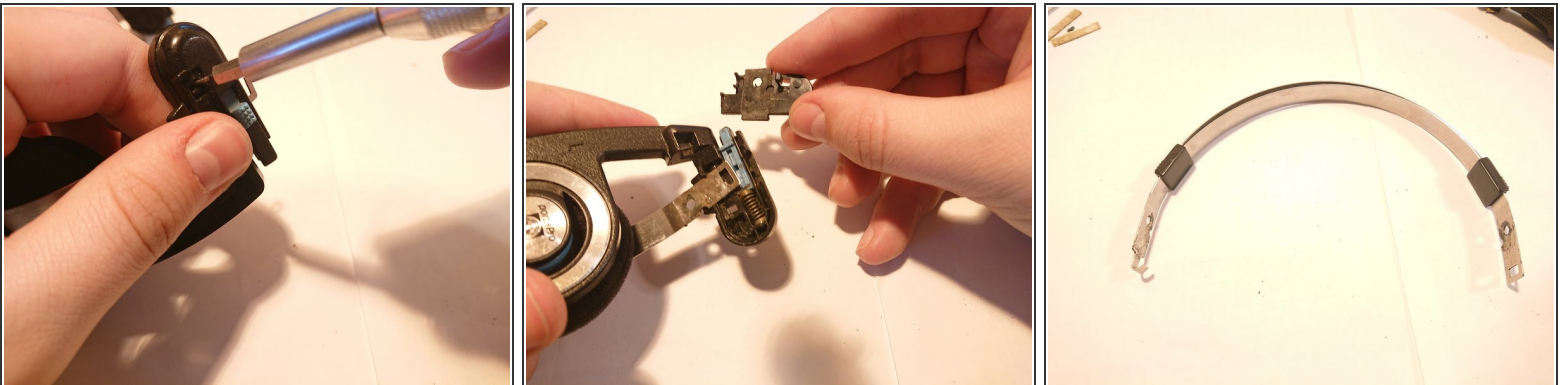


### Step 3 — Remove clip



- Use screwdriver to start bending edges of clip.
  - Continue bending with pliers or cutters.
  - Push clip with screwdriver and pull with cutters from another side.
-  This step can take up to 15 minutes, so keep calm and continue bending.

### Step 4 — Remove hoop holder



- Press tenon using screwdriver to remove shield.
- Remove hoop from hoop holder.

## Step 5 — Assemble hoop holder



- Place hoop in hoop holer.
- Close hoop holder with shield.
- Insert M2.5x8 screw into hole and tighten the nut.

## Step 6 — Stick cushion and label



- Stick comfortZone label over the screw. Use double-sided foam tape if head of screw is too high.
- Stick cushion. Use additional double-sided tape if cushion has bad holding.

Left and right sides are the same so you can use this guide for both.
