

# **Lenovo Legion Y530-15ICH Battery Replacement**

If your Lenovo Legion Y530-15ICH isn't powering...

#### INTRODUCTION

If your Lenovo Legion Y530-15ICH isn't powering on or holding a charge then you should use this guide to replace the battery.

The battery provides power to the rest of the computer. If your computer won't power on, you may have a faulty power cord or just need to restart your computer. Your problem may be due to a faulty battery or your battery may also be swollen.

Please make sure the laptop is powered off completely and unplugged before beginning.

### Step 1 — Back Cover



# ⚠ Ensure the device is powered off.

- Use a PZ00 screwdriver bit to remove the eleven screws securing the back cover.
  - Five 7 mm screws
  - Six 4 mm screws

## Step 2





- Carefully pry the back cover off the computer using an opening pick.
- ② Start at the corner of the laptop and work your way around the side. Gently pull up on the cover until it detaches.

### Step 3 — Battery



 Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the five 4 mm screws holding the battery in place.

### Step 4



- Disconnect the battery cable from its motherboard socket by gently pulling it towards the battery.
  - ⚠ Pull parallel to the battery, not straight up.
- (i) Now you can safely remove the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

For optimal performance, after completing this guide, <u>calibrate</u> your newly installed battery.

Take your e-waste to an R2 or e-Stewards certified recycler.
