## INTRODUCTION

This guide will demonstrate how to increase the life of the air filter for the Honda HRR216 lawnmower.

Maintaining the filter is something that I do after every summer due to how often I use the lawnmower.

Steps 1,2,5, and 6 in this guide can also be used for removing or replacing the filter, as it will eventually wear down.

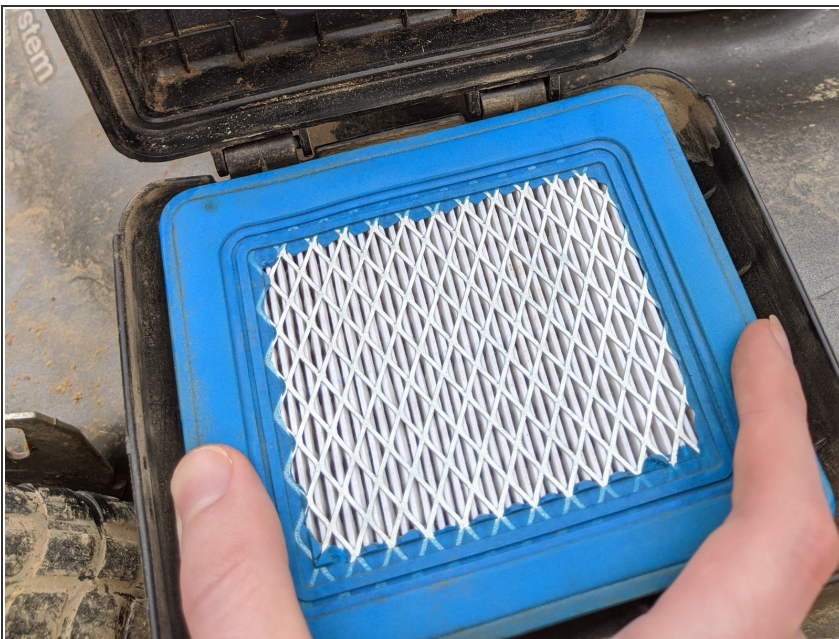
## Step 1 — Air Filter



**⚠ Make sure that the motor is off and has had time to cool after being used.**

- Push in the clips on the top of the cover, and remove the cover.

## Step 2



- Make a note of the position of the filter, and remove the cover.

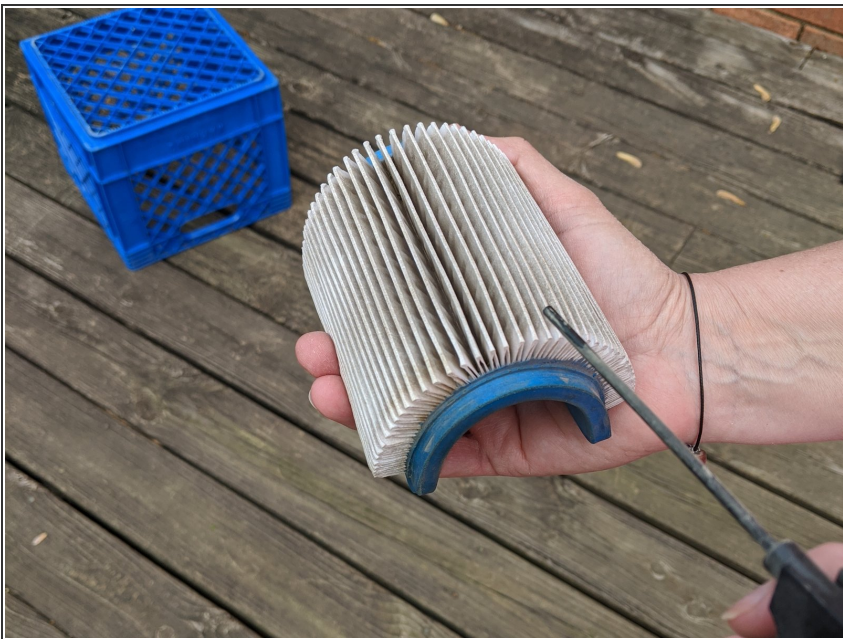


### Step 3



- Lightly bend the filter so that you can see all surfaces of the filter.

### Step 4



- Use compressed air to blow out dirt or dust particles from the air filter.
- ⓘ You can bend it in several places to make sure you clean between each of the fins.

## Step 5



- Seat the filter in the same position you made a note of in Step 2.
- ⓘ If the filter is still bent from cleaning it, lightly bend it in the opposite direction so that it can lay flat in your hand.
- Place the cover onto the air filter. This shouldn't require any force, so the filter may need to be readjusted if it does require force.

## Step 6



- Push the clips of the cover in until they click.
- Check to make sure that the cover is secure, and there are no gaps for dirt or dust to get in.
