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INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace the back cover of your Panasonic Lumix DMC-ZS3 camera, which houses the back panel buttons and LCD screen.

🖌 TOOLS:

Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1) Spudger (1)


Step 1 — Back Cover



- Remove the following eleven screws securing the covers to the ZS3
- Eleven 3 mm Phillips screws

⚠ Using too much pressure when removing the screws may strip the screws and complicate screw removal at a later time.

Step 2



• Use the flat end of a spudger to pry apart the back cover from the rest of the unit as shown.

A Be sure to carefully and slowly lift the back cover. Forcefully lifting the back cover and fully separating it at this point may ruin internal connections.

Step 3



• Using your fingernail or a spudger, flip up the ZIF locking flap on the two LCD ribbon cable sockets that connect the back cover to the rest of the unit.

A Be sure you are opening the locking tab, not pulling against the socket mounted to the board.

Step 4



 Remove the two LCD board ribbon cables out of their sockets. To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
