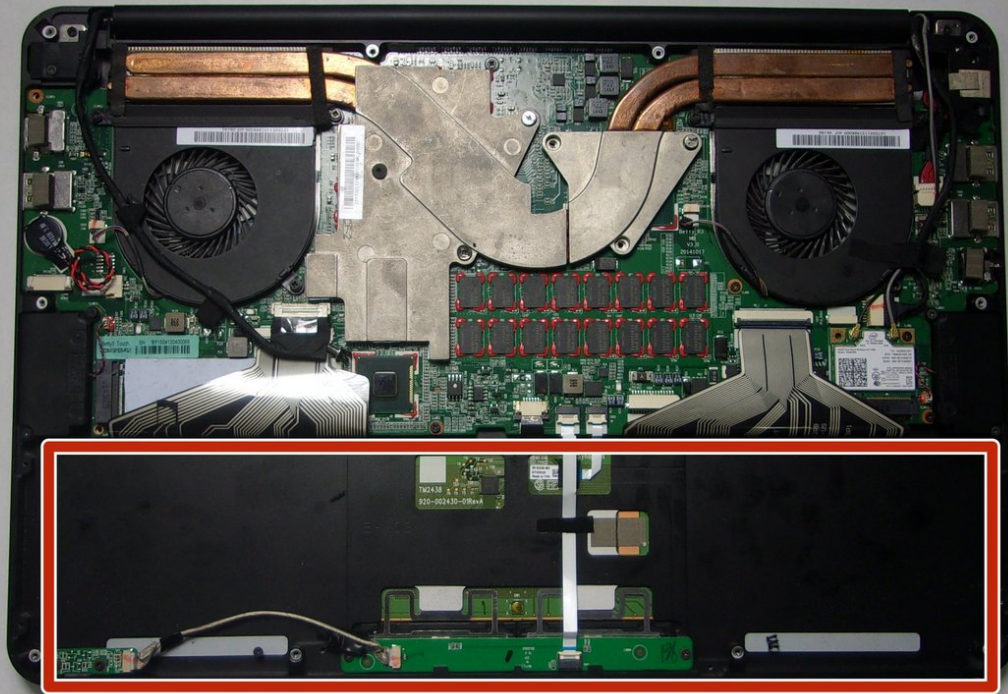




Razer Blade RZ09-0130 2015 Battery Replacement

INTRODUCTION

Over time, lithium-ion batteries inevitably degrade, dramatically reducing their lifespan. The higher operating temperatures in gaming laptops speeds up their degradation; if you've been using your Razer Blade RZ09-0130 2015 for more than a couple years, and the battery life is either very short, or it can't even run while unplugged, it's definitely time for a replacement.

Before beginning these guide, make sure that the system is shut down, unplugged, and that there is no static build up on your person.

If you find your [battery is swollen](#), take extreme caution in removal, and [dispose of your battery](#) through the proper channels.

Step 1 — Back Panel



⚠ Be sure to power off the device before beginning.

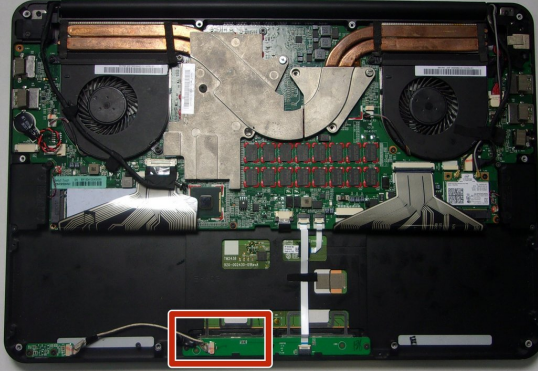
- Use a Torx T5 screwdriver to remove the ten 3 mm screws along the edge of the back panel.

Step 2



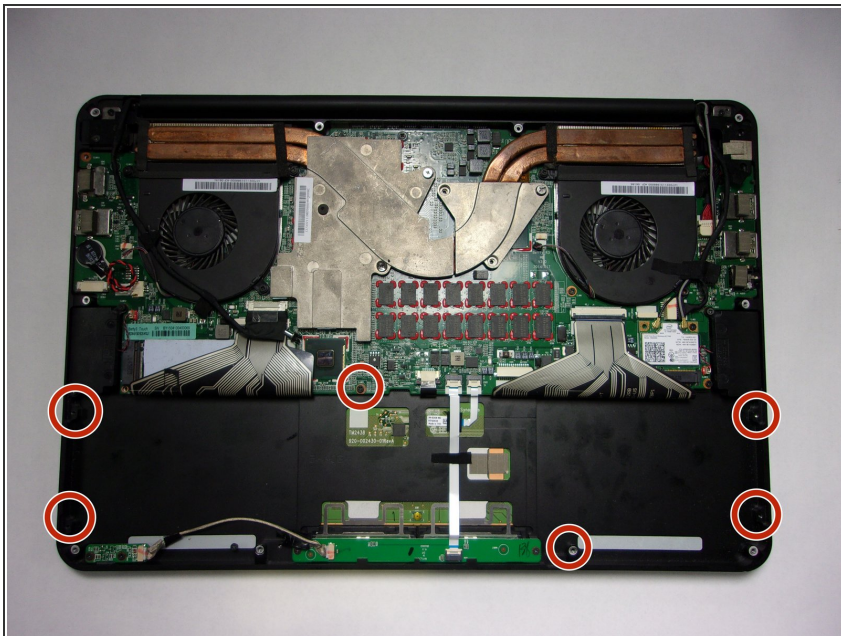
- Remove the back panel from the laptop by sliding it away from the hinge.
- ⓘ This device is missing the battery. Make sure to detach the battery connector before proceeding with laptop repairs.

Step 3 — Battery



- Detach the battery's ribbon cable from the motherboard.

Step 4



- Use a Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the six 3 mm screws securing the battery.
- Lift the battery up and out.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
