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INTRODUCTION

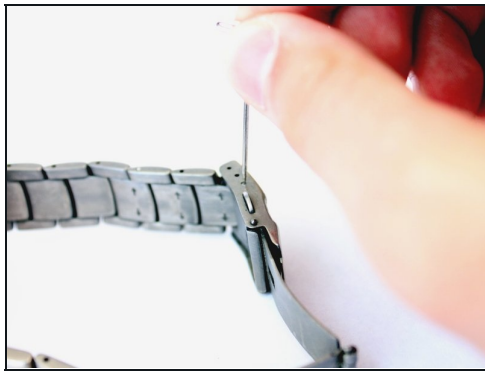
Sometimes, fixing a watch is as simple as replacing a watch battery. Instead of taking the watch to a professional, replacing the battery can be done quickly and easily in the comfort of your own home. Here we will teach you to remove the battery and put a new one in with a few simple steps.

TOOLS:

Push Pin (1)

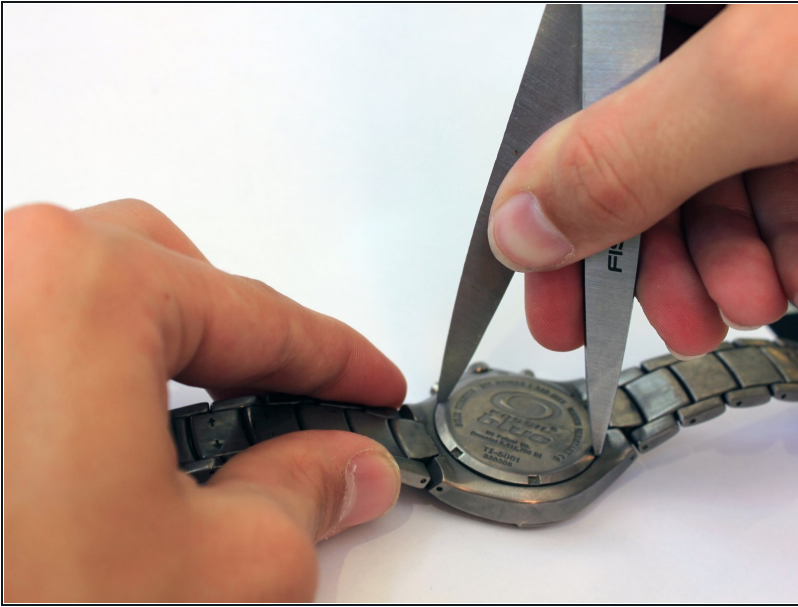
Scissors (1)

Step 1 — Clasp



- Keep clasp in open position.
- Push one of the spring-loaded pins out of the hole with a Push-pin.
- Wiggle watch band and clasp till free from each other.

Step 2 — Back



- Fit the blades of a pair of scissors into the grooves of the screw back.
- Twist the screw back counter clockwise with the scissors.
- Once the back is loose enough, you can use your fingers to twist it off.

Step 3 — Battery



- Place the [tweezers](#) around the battery.
- Firmly grip the battery with the tweezers.
- Pull the battery out and replace it with a new 371 Renata watch battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
