#### **INTRODUCTION**

Use this guide to replace the LCD screen on your Canon EOS Rebel T3i.



## **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

#### Step 1 — Battery



 Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the camera.

#### Step 2



- Hook your finger onto the compartment door latch.
- Open the battery compartment door.

#### Step 3



Remove the battery from the compartment.

#### Step 4 — Screen






Remove the two 3 mm Phillips #000 screws. The screws are on opposite sides of the screen.

## Step 5



Remove the plastic backing.

## Step 6



 Unplug the blue cable from the back of the LCD.

## Step 7





- Remove the two 3 mm Phillips #000 screws.
- Separate the LCD from the plastic housing.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
