


# **HP Stream 8 Motherboard Replacement**

#### TOOLS:

Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1) Tweezers (1)

## Step 1 — Midframe




 Use your nail or a spudger to pry the back cover off of the device.




 Slide your finger around the rest of the back cover, lifting it completely off of the device.

## Step 3




• Remove ten Phillips #00 screws from the inside cover.




• Pry up the inside cover the same way as in the first step.

#### Step 5 — Front-Facing Camera




 Lift up on the small black tab at the connection point to unlock the flex ribbon cable using the tweezers.




• Remove the front facing camera with tweezers.

#### **Step 7 — Rear-Facing Camera**




• Carefully pry up the gray metal piece on the end of the flex ribbon cable using tweezers.



 Remove the back facing camera with the tweezers.

#### Step 9 — Motherboard



• Carefully remove the battery connector from the system board using the tweezers.



 Lift up on the small black tab to unlock the LCD screen flex ribbon cable using the tweezers.

#### Step 11




 Carefully remove the LCD screen flex ribbon cable from the system board using the tweezers.




• Carefully remove the USB flex ribbon cable from the connection point on the system board using the tweezers.

#### Step 13



 Remove the two Phillips using the screwdriver with a PH00 Phillips head.



 Remove the motherboard from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
