

# Sony DVP-FX730 Monitor Replacement

#### **INTRODUCTION**

If the monitor or screen is broken, the monitor needs to be detached from the Sony DVP-FX730. To detach the monitor successfully, a screwdriver should be used to remove screws, use your hands to pull remove a small back cover, and use tweezers to remove wires attached to bases.



## **TOOLS:**

- Tweezers (1)
- Spudger (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Cover



- Remove the five exposed 7.9 mm screws using a Phillips screwdriver.
- Punch through the warranty sticker with the spudger.
  - Remove the screw underneath with the Phillips screwdriver.

## Step 2




- Remove the rubber feet using the spudger.
- Remove the screws that were covered by the rubber feet.

# Step 3



- Hold on to the corners of the cover and gently lift the cover.
- ↑ The tray is still connected to the base with wires.

# Step 4



 Gently remove the wires with tweezers by pulling up on the base they are attached to.

#### Step 5 — Monitor





Use your hand to remove the small back cover by gently pulling upward.

# Step 6




Using a screwdriver, remove the two
12 mm pan head screws.

# Step 7



- The screen should now detach from the primary device.
- The wires, indicated with a blue box, will still connect the screen.


# Step 8






Remove the wires attached to the white base using tweezers to pull them up.

## Step 9





Referring back to Step 8, do the same with the wires attached to the black base.

## Step 10



 The screen should now be completely separated from the main device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
