## INTRODUCTION



- A wide variety of household and kitchen items turn up at our Restart Parties. Here's what we've learned about them.
  - <u>Vacuum cleaners</u> can be a messy job, especially if the owner didn't realise you have to empty the bag occasionally!
  - <u>Table lamps</u> quite often an easy fix and people just love it when you fix one they've had for years.
  - <u>Sewing machines</u> a popular page, and if you're more used to electronic gadgets an easy way to extend your range.
  - <u>Digital weighing scales</u> usually pretty reliable, but faced with one, would you know how it works?
  - <u>Toasters</u> if yours is toast then maybe you can fix it.
  - <u>Steam irons</u> when the water gets where it shouldn't then it there may not be much you can do, but first let's get inside the thing!
